- Only the Word File of the Research Paper will be accepted for publication.
- Manuscript should not be in more than 2500 words (8-10 A-4 size pages).
- Line spacing should be 1.5, and should be in Times New Roman-12 point font for English papers, and Kruti dev 10-14 point font for Hindi papers.
- 5-8 key words and references must be there in the research paper.
